



NRG Oncology @ 10 Years

In 10 Years NRG has

- Activated 93 trials
- Enrolled 32,317 patients to our trials
- Enrolled 3,481patients from 15 international sites on 66 trials
- Published 762 manuscripts
- Presented 708 abstracts at scientific meetings



NRG Oncology @ 10 Years

Today NRG has

- 51 trials open for enrollment
- 69 trials collecting follow-up data
- 2,063 member sites in 49 states, Puerto Rico, Guam and 15 countries
 - 197 Main Member + 1,866 Affiliates
 - 185 sites with minority/underserved populations

- Started in 2021 by NCORP PI Joan Walker to train earlystage investigators in the NRG Oncology system through a structured mentorship experience with an emphasis on recruitment of researchers from underrepresented groups.
- 2-Year Fellowship with support of \$25,000 per year
- Funding obtained via private donations
- 3 Fellowships awarded that started in 2022
- 3 More awarded to start in 2023.
