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NRG Oncology Meeting Photography/Videography Policy

All attendees and presenters at an NRG Oncology Meeting acknowledge that their attendance is subject to the following policy:

1. Presentations delivered at NRG Oncology Meetings remain the intellectual property of their respective authors. NRG Oncology retains a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use, reproduce, and distribute meeting presentations and associated materials for NRG organizational purposes.
2. Commercial use of recordings or reproductions of any presentations are strictly prohibited without the consent of NRG Oncology.
3. Non-flash photography and audio or video recording using hand-held devices solely for personal, non-commercial use is permitted. All such activity is permitted only to the extent that it is not disruptive and is not otherwise prohibited by NRG Oncology due to regulatory or contractual agreements.
4. Social media posting is permitted provided it is not for commercial gain.
5. NRG Oncology will clearly mark restricted sessions with signage and/or verbal announcements at the start of the session. Attendees are responsible for complying with posted restrictions.
6. Attendees who post photographs, video and or audio recordings online agree to remove and/or delete any image or recording within 48 hours of written notice from NRG Oncology. Failure to comply may result in enforcement action under the NRG Oncology Code of Conduct, and NRG Oncology reserves the right to submit platform takedown requests.
7. NRG Oncology may secure an official photographer/videographer to document and capture meeting sessions, discussions and other events at the NRG Oncology Meeting and may photograph or record the meeting.
8. Any individual attending the meeting understands that their likeness (photograph, image, voice, or reproduction, including slide presentations, thereof captured during the NRG Oncology Meeting, either in whole or in part) may be used for NRG Oncology's promotional, educational, and organizational purposes, including but not limited to social media, website, newsletter, and other organizational materials.
